

### The work completed served our souls and in the process it provided the following to Christ's Church:

- > Completed over 50 SPFL programs in 7 different countries.
- > Served over 25,000 volunteer hours of service work to monks, nuns, and parishes while building, restoring, and renovating churches, monasteries, convents, and parishioners' homes.
- > Constructed two churches including St. Xenia Church in Guatemala and St. Spyridon Church in Long Island, Bahamas.
- > Filmed, edited, and produced over a dozen films and documentaries that have been used to promote Holy Orthodoxy, support the sale of monastery wares, and educate the public.
- > Brought Orthodox Christian youth and families from 14 countries around the world for 3 day to 6 week long service programs.
- > Served countless liturgies, services, spiritual talks and discussions on Holy Orthodox Christianity.
- ➤ Recruited and helped staff volunteers for Church fundraising events, festivals, and conferences that helped support our Orthodox Communities financially in the tens of thousands of dollars over the years.
- Brought a Guatemalan family out of poverty through the success of the "Herman House Poverty and Housing Program."



# DESCRIPTIONS 2014/2015

- 1. St. Spyridon's Church in Long Island, Bahamas offers a 2 week service trip filled with service, sun, and sand! Come help complete the construction of the Church. (December Schedule, Coed)
- 2. St. Xenia Church in Guatemala City, Guatemala offers a 1 week service trip during the feast of St. Xenia that provides an opportunity for service work, soup kitchen activities, and the assistance of impoverished Orthodox Christians living in Guatemala. (February Schedule, Coed)
- 3. The Holy Ascension Monastery in Bearsville, New York offers a one week service trip to assist the fathers of the monastery with the building of the Hagia Sophia and the demands of the up keep of the monastery. (Week of the Feast of Holy Ascension, Male)
- **4.** The Holy Dormition Monastery in Upstate, New York is a one week service trip that serves the dwelling of Fr. Damian and the hermitage he founded there. (July, Coed)
- 5. St. Peter and Paul's Church in Mt. Union, Pennsylvania provides long weekend and weeklong service opportunities for both Church maintenance projects as well as food festival fundraisers. (Fall Schedule, Coed)
- **6.** The Pilgrimage to the Holy Land in Egypt and Israel offers pilgrims a guided tour of the New Testament and Mount Sinai. (Winter and Summer Schedule, Coed)
- 7. St. Syncletike Convent in Farmingdale, New York provides volunteers an opportunity for fellowship as you help the nuns with their annual feast day preparations and to do list at the convent. (June Schedule, Coed)
